Elementary School Level

- An investment club where students learn fundamentals of investing in the stock market
- An all school program to create a scale model of the Town of Franklin
- Portable document cameras to develop student mathematics skills including modeling and answering MCAS open response questions
- Materials for the launch of a before school breakfast book club
- Sponsorship of “In My Shoes - Disability Awareness” Unit

Middle School Level

- Development of the classroom-based library tailored to the specific interests and abilities of students who have significant reading disabilities to develop literary skills
- Enhancement of the Holocaust unit through the creation of a memorial quilt and funding of a panel discussion with Holocaust survivors
- An aquatic learning center allowing students to conduct authentic research in the roles that organisms play in the ecosystem
- Purchase of “Project Adventure”, to develop small group problem solving skills
- Funding for numerous poets, writers and authors in residence
- Sponsorship of a *Health Snack Cart* planned and operated by special needs students

High School Level

- Interactive world language activities developed through technology including PowerPoint presentations and online Internet research to support language studies and video production
- Initial sponsor of *Empty Bowls*; a creative arts program designed to support the Franklin Food Pantry
- Purchase of "Arc View Business Analyst" software for the Entrepreneurship DECA classes
- Establishment of a literacy support program for students with mild to moderate learning disabilities
- Funding for speakers for “Encouraging Careers in Math, Science and Technology for High School Junior Women” seminar series
